
- Take pride in your appearance.

Chattanooga Prep Way: Lifework



- Homework is called LIFEWORK at Chattanooga Prep because we believe words are powerful.
- It prepares students for life they become better readers, mathematicians, scientists, historians, writers. However, what's more important they get on the path to becoming a man.
- Lifework is about being responsible with your time, being held accountable to your actions, and used as an extension of what you learned that day.
- Expect lifework and a reading log every single night.
- A Harvard Study showed homework done with effort and oversight is one
 of the quickest ways to gain academic achievement.

Chattanooga Prep Way: Lifework



- Lifework will be turned in every morning during breakfast, or at the front desk, if you are late.
- If lifework is not turned in with effort and 100% completion the prepater will have study hall that afternoon, which is done at 5:30pm.
 - o Communication will be sent out should your prepster have to attend study hall
- If homework is completed at study hall the student will receive 75% credit, but if it is not completed during that allotted time they will receive no credit.



Chattanooga Prep Way: Brotherhood



- Promoting Brotherhood:
 - Lock-In
 - Built in social time
 - Voting based on leadership qualities prepsters will choose who their leader will be.
 - After school activities Prepster will know they have a community that they belong to. We will have multiple activities for prepsters to participate in.
 - Chess
 - STEAM Team
 - Robotics
 - Basketball
 - Soccer
 - Music: Guitar

Chattanooga Prep Way: Leadership



- Developing Leaders:
 - Town Hall
 - Prepsters will be challenged personally, share life experiences, and understand the importance of expressing emotions.
 - Prepsters will also learn about the character strengths and experiences of various leaders (new and old) they can identify with.











Chattanooga Prep Way: Involved!



100% Engagement:

- Paying attention 100% of the time by 100% of the students is what is expected.
- It is too difficult to teach at a high rigor if students aren't attentive.
- Teachers will be coached to reach this difficult bar and prepsters will be expected to meet that bar.

Parent Expectations:


- Commitment to the Prep way.
